

About this Document

In the Fall of 2001, Intermediate School District 287 was awarded funding from the Goals 2000 grant for the Systems Integration Project for staff development. As a part of the Systems Integration Project and in collaboration with Intermediate Districts 916 and 917, 287 district staff worked to develop guidelines for integrating Minnesota graduation standards with Career and Technical Education.
